Back To Church Sunday is a national church event on the 3rd Sunday of September each year where the churches of America are encouraged to invite their communities to church!

The National Back to Church Sunday movement started 15 years ago as a call to action and an invitation – action for the church, and an invitation for the world. A single-day event focused on extending the invitation of love, peace, and hope of Jesus to our friends and neighbors.

Join Us for the Funding Forward Course!

Funding Forward provides the tools and insights to move beyond the constant worry about finances to listen to God's voice more clearly. We invite everyone to participate in this collaborative learning experience as we explore innovative solutions to creating financially sustainable ministry models. This course is designed with the understanding that each church's path to financial sustainability is as unique as its mission and community. This is not just about financial management; it's a journey of faith, stewardship, and community building by discerning God's mission for our congregation, understanding how we can meet the tangible needs of our local community, and using underutilized congregational assets.

The learning modules will include topics like why tithes and offerings are no longer enough for most congregations; identifying our congregation's assets; discerning God's mission; aligning money and mission; reimagining our congregation's property; exploring social enterprises; shifting our congregation's staffing model; finding funding; and shifting our congregation's financial model. Each session will include short videos, time in God's Word, conversation, brainstorming, and more.

We will hear some examples from other churches that are trying different ways of serving their community; using their resources; working with other ministry organizations and more. What might it look like to rent out some of our unused building space? How about allowing people to use our commercial kitchen? Let's explore this course together and see where God might lead us to discover new opportunities for church funding and deepen our connection with God and our community. Sign up on the kiosk.



Thrivent Action Teams

Did you know that anyone who is a Thrivent client is eligible to lead a Thrivent Action Team? Clients with benefit membership are eligible to lead two Thrivent Action Teams per calendar year, and clients with associate membership are eligible to lead one per calendar year.

What is an Action Team?

It is a team of friends, family, neighbors, or church members that work together to put on a fundraiser, educational event, or service activity. Thrivent will provide up to \$250 in seed money for the project.

How does it work?

- 1. Any Thrivent member can apply to lead a project. You sign up on Thrivent.com.
- 2. When you are approved, Thrivent sends you an action kit with resources to support your project. This includes A Community Impact Card with up to \$250 in seed money.
- 3. You and your team bring the project to life.
- 4. You report the completion of the project to Thrivent and share the story of your impact.

Here are some examples:

- An action team card purchased the food for the bingo event making it possible for all of the proceeds to go to the food pantry.
- Action Team cards were used to purchase towels and other supplies for the Personal Care Kits
- An Action Team card was used for the Mother's Day and Father's Day brunches

If you are a Thrivent member, consider how you might make use of a Thrivent Action Team. It could be used to support one of the upcoming M-Team events. Maybe you have an idea for an educational event or an outreach event or a fundraiser. If you don't have an idea but are willing to apply for a card, let Michelle or Pastor Rebekah know and they will make a note in the office.

The M-team and Worship Committee are working on plans for several upcoming events. Mark these dates on your calendars so that you can be part of the celebration.
